I was a NatSci in Clare and have just started my PhD in Physics. I have always loved the idea of volunteering and being able to make a positive impact in the local community. I have done lots of volunteering work in the past but nothing could really compare with the experience I have had with the 14th Cambridge Scout Group. I joined them a year ago, having no experience in Scouting whatsoever. Since then I have learnt many new skills, done things I would have never done without Scouting, met people from all walks of life and had a fabulous time with them.
