Experience

- From 2016-17, I was the elected secretary of a North West regional youth charity 'YouthFocus NW'. The role involved disseminating information, minutes and opportunities to over 200 young people aged 12-19 and professional youth workers across the North West region, including Liverpool and Manchester authorities.
