IDEAS:

Refreshers' Week

- Consult students on when mocks are so we can ensure majority of events can be enjoyed by everyone
- Ensure timetable remains new and exciting – consider new events including but not limited to: college bar crawl, refreshers house party, bowling, paintballing etc
- Scrap tshirts for bar crawl to reduce cost to just club ticket
- Continue to offer subsidised tickets for club nights

Freshers' Week

- Secure more tickets for club nights
- Ensure corridor dinners get organised
- Lengthen freshers' week to second weekend of term with extra events e.g. as above, trip to adc, go-karting, coffee crawl etc
- Ensure feedback from last year is acted upon

FULS

- Reduce FULS ticket prices (aim for sub £5) using profit made from freshers' week
- Ensure we do not run out of alcohol by increasing order size
- Enquire about feasibility of extending alcohol license so bar doesn't need to close at 12am
- Request permission from college to run event later (current finish is 1 for 1:30 exit)
- Get college to buy a replacement stage for the one they sold 'by accident'

Bops

- Run more bops in clubs (like our Bridgemas bop with Catz and Churchill)

- Implement Yusuf's President manifesto idea for genre specific bop nights

Club night tickets

- Continue efforts to secure club tickets
- We are currently on the waiting list for Weds Cindies but push to get Friday Cindies, Thursday Lolas etc

Garden Party / Billy's Day / Wonderland

- Work with the Sports and Societies President to make the case for a larger budget for Billy's Day - should be a great community college event during May Week
- Push to model Billy's Day on June Events, although maintain it as free event - BBQ, refreshments, sporting events incl. 5 a side final etc
- Investigate feasibility for running a Winter Wonderland event again in December of the 'off-ball' years

Pub Quizzes

- Make the pub quiz a more regular feature of the term calendar – perhaps running a quiz every other week

JCR Improvements

- Get a permanent laptop/computer in the JCR so people don't need to bring their own to use the projector
- Stream more sports / tv programmes / documentaries in the JCR for all to enjoy

More JCR social events

- Organise more social events for the JCR to foster a good working relationship and provide some further incentive for future JCR involvement
