 - 0 Working alongside the Fitz Art Soc- casual, week 5 drawing starting next term
- Continuing Welfare Drop-ins:
 - 0 Weekly casual chats in the Café or JCR
- Good Lad programme:
 - 0 Workshops, tackling toxic masculinity, making people aware of micro-aggressions, how to avoid being a bystander
 - 0 These should run alongside the other workshops given during freshers' week
- Casual Study Groups
 - 0 Regular weekend study groups open to all
- Library Sweep:
 - 0 Deliver sweets to anyone working late in the library, check whether they are okay!
 - 0 This should happen throughout the year, not solely during exam term.
- Mental Health Walks:
 - 0 Sunday afternoon/evening- break up the day. Get people outside.
 - 0 The weekends, can in many ways, be the most difficult time of the week.
- Charity events:
 - 0 Mental health formal working alongside other colleges
 - 0 Possibly annual college rounders
 - 0 Getting people involved, bringing people together.
 - 0 Working alongside CALM (Campaign Against Living Miserably), who are supportive of events
- Welfare Gardening
 - 0 Work alongside the Green Officer(s) to run a weekly therapeutic gardening session!
 - 0 Making better use of the allotment
- Raising awareness for eating disorders
 - 0 More information on the college website and around college on spotting the signs of eating disorders.
 - 0 Tackling common misconceptions around eating disorders
- Termly meetings with the Senior Tutor
 - 0 Push for the Senior Tutor to be more proactive when it comes to student welfare
- Welfare Massages:
 - 0 In theory, this is a brilliant scheme, however there are a very limited number of spaces.
 - 0 Make the scheme balloted rather than having a first come first serve basis
