 - 0 Consultation- sending out drafts of this framework to...
 - Previous Sports and Socs Presidents for rules of thumb, starting points etc.
 - Previous sport funding recipients, potentially through College sport captains.
 - 0 Publicity: include these in the guidelines for application for funding on Moodle
 - 0 Accountability:
 - Would at least create mechanism for complaints to be sent in regarding distribution of sports funding, to improve the process for future
 - Investigate the possibility of allowing appeals to these decisions
 - 0 Why am I the best person to run this?
 - I'm a Law nerd that will be sad enough to enjoy it
 - Advocate an open, way of performing this very important function
- Create and publicise (through websites, Facebook, noticeboards) instructions as to how to set up a new society, and when this is necessary/desirable

- Help to facilitate and guide greater use of society resources for individual projects
 - 0 E.g. creating clear conditions for use of FCMS resources for one-off concerts
