Danni volunteered to be on the Fitz Fine Arts committee to decide what to do with work sent in by Fitz Undergrads and Postgrads.

Burns night:

Six volunteers are needed to help with clean-up before and after Burns night formal and ceilidh on Wednesday 20th. Carl, Annabel, Helen, Nivvi, Ilona have volunteered so far.

Also, it was stressed that committee needs to volunteer for events.

Actions to be taken:

Rooms for non-Fitz students:

Room costs for non-Fitz committees, like the Yoga society (about £40 every Sunday) is being very restrictive. In fact the Yoga society has to change college as they can't afford this price - also as these sessions was originally set up at first as a Welfare, it would be a shame if they have to change college.

This is the case due to budget concerns. Also, Fitz could end up losing out on revenue if rooms were given out for free. On the other hand, societies could start using other college facilities (e.g. Churchill, Emma, Homerton).

Actions to be taken: Fenella to find out if rooms can booked for free or at least whether prices could be reduced

Any other business:

-Food being served from college bar:

Serving food from College bar would be helpful for students coming back late to college etc. It was decided that Paninis and microwave foods (possibly jackets potatoes) would be relatively easy foods to serve.

-Free Coffee:

It could be used as an incentive for JCR members to do work (i.e. the privilege could be taken away). However, it could also be seen as a reward for helping at events. Fenella to find out if this could be put into action.
